



Peninsula Home & Remodel Expo Building Challenge *Using LEGO® Brand Building Blocks**

Rules Overview:

- 1) Each participant will be provided a bucket of blocks to use along with their imagination to build a home. Anything you have in your bucket can be used. You do not need to use every piece. The only structural requirement is that the building includes a space for a door. You may not have a LEGO® door in your bucket so just create an opening as if it were a door.
- 2) You can only use the building blocks that you have in your bucket. You cannot borrow from another participant or use any blocks of your own. The table is divided and each participant will have a designated space for their home construction project. Please do not intermix blocks with your neighbor.
- 3) The buckets are similar but may not be identical – use what was provided to you as best as you can.
- 4) No help can be provided – you must build the home yourself.
- 5) There will be volunteers in the area to answer questions. If you have a question, please raise your hand and someone will come over to help you.
- 6) You will have 30 minutes to build your home. We will let you know when the contest is over. You must stop building as soon as we announce the end of the building phase of the contest.
- 7) The judges will move through the area scoring the participant's projects. There will be one first-place winner announced for each of the three age groups (5-7, 8-9, and 10-12). Each of the 1st Place Winners will be awarded an age-appropriate LEGO® brand construction set. Each of the participants not awarded 1st place will leave with a LEGO® brand gift. Winners will be announced about 15 minutes after the building challenge ends. You must be present to win.
- 8) DO NOT TEAR down your projects until after the judges have completed their scoring and your family has been able to take a photo of your project.
- 9) The building blocks used for this challenge are the property of the Kitsap Building Association and are not to be removed from the Challenge area.
- 10) Congratulations on agreeing to participate! Good luck in the challenge and remember to be creative, think fast, and have fun!
